3. To receive an annual report from the Chair of the Parish Council

2025/26 has been a solid and steady year in maintaining our responsibilities towards the parish of Nettleton and the community we serve

We started out the year with a commitment to improve the Asset Register and we now have a complete inventory of the assets we are responsible for, where they are, their general condition and a projection of costs associated with maintaining them in the longer term

We also carried a number of either reactive or proactive maintenance and improvement activities on those assets through the year to ensure the safety and increased amenity value for the people using them:

- Play Park path
- Play Park benches
- Play Park Gates
- Bus Shelter Safety Supports
- Also renewed the 3 year grass cutting contract in recognition of excellent service from AJ Williams)

Also the supporting administration for the council is in great shape now with all the relevant policies, procedures and other necessary documents in place and up to date with another successful Internal Audit 'clean bill of health' achieved

The Parish Council acts as a consultee for planning applications and always submits comments and in some cases has needed to challenge them when not in keeping with the heritage and character of the village

Proactive events were limited but we managed to hold a small Dog Show at the end of the summer in 2025 which was quite well supported given the short planning time. Generally it went well and was certainly appreciated by those attending

Moving into 2026/27, Parish Councillor numbers remain a concern and whilst we can continue to fully maintain our usual responsibilities the wider proactive things we would like to deliver for the

community are on hold in lieu of resources being available to carry them through. Increasing councillor numbers and finding resources to help support the more proactive events etc. is a focus for the coming year.
